How do I pay the Visa Application Charge?

- 1. Payable in Mauritian rupees in cash at the Australian High Commission in Port Louis during designated Visa Counter hours
- 2. By bank issued cheque in Mauritian Rupees only made payable to 'Australian High Commission'
- 3. Via a Credit card (either your own or someone else's with their approval). The credit card is charged in AUD. The credit card details should be included in your visa application form (in the payment section) note: there is an additional credit card surcharge payable
- 4. A person pays on your behalf at one of the Immigration Offices in Australia (in AUD) and sends you a copy of the receipt.

<u>For online visa applications</u>: The visa application charge is payable by credit card only and charged in AUD).

Please note: The Visa Application Charge is for the processing of the application and must be paid <u>regardless</u> of the application outcome. There are only limited circumstances in which refunds can be given.
